Dear Prospective Families:

Thank you for your interest in Cedar Tree and in classical Christian education. We are a community committed to providing a nurturing and challenging educational environment for your children and your family. Our teachers seek to cultivate students by encouraging academic and spiritual development in every activity. Our integrated curriculum is richly influenced by the classical tradition of learning.

After we receive all your completed application forms, you will be contacted to schedule a time for a family interview and student assessment (often this can be done on the same visit). Along the way, we encourage parents to have scheduled a visit to observe a class in order to witness classical Christian education firsthand.

I will conduct the family interview with you personally so that we can get to know one another better and help ensure that Cedar Tree and classical Christian education are a good fit for your family. Please read through the Parent-Student Handbook (available online) and bring any questions you might have.

All prospective students are assessed in various skill areas (particularly reading, math, and writing) so that we can place them in the grade level where they will be most successful at Cedar Tree.

After all these steps are completed, we will let you know your status (whether your application is accepted, denied or your child is placed on the waiting list) and the grade level placement we recommend. It usually takes at least a week for us to process all the information, depending on circumstances.
